Wells Fargo Special Project</u> <u>Account</u> #5730834990; Routing # 031000503, to secure and confirm their seats. <u>The</u> <u>deadline to submit photos and support statement is November 16th.</u> Grand Patrons and Patrons will be recognized and provided certificates of appreciation during the gala on December 16th, and the *names of Grand Patrons will be among those to be etched on the cornerstone of the school of the performing arts building when completed*.

B. Individuals who fall in the <u>"Supporters"</u> and "General Admission" categories must confirm and pay their admission fees via payment options above as soon as possible to reserve their seats.
